NORTHRUP distinctly awears to their being the persons,-and told how he was hired at Saratoga Springs in 1841, to go South with them to join a Oircus, and treated in Washington with drugged liquor, &c., &c., A witness was 'in Court who drank with NonTHEUP and his kidnappers at Washington, the night before he was put in the Slave pen,-and it is expected that a witness willo one forward and testity to having heard MERNILL tell of selling NORTHRUP

The accused were discovered from the descriptions and incidents given in NORTHRUP's book.
